We have been sharing our plans with you on reopening the Kentucky School for the Deaf (KSD) and we wanted to provide you with an update, as I value being a part of your child's education and always want to ensure an open line of communication.

As you may know, the number of COVID-19 cases is increasing statewide, and that number is predicted to continue to increase with cooler temperatures leading to more indoor activities. The number of cases in Boyle County currently is in the accelerated stage and moving closer to the critical stage.

Therefore, KSD is pausing plans to return to any in-person instruction at this time. We will continue with virtual instruction for all students.

We are working closely with the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) and our partners in public health to design an alternative plan. We will provide more information when it is available.

We want to thank you for your patience and flexibility during this unprecedented time.
